Hardrock Centre Rules

- All participants must complete an Agreement Form.
- All new visitors to this centre must complete a Safety Instruction prior to using Hardrock facilities.
- The 5-Step Belay method is the only method to be used while belaying in this centre.
- The use of personal belay devices on top-ropes is not permitted.
- Belaying requires your undivided attention. The use of mobile phones or cameras is not permitted while belaying.
- Children under the age of 11 are not permitted to belay under any circumstances.
- While top-rope climbing you must be connected by dual attachment of a Karabiner and a rethreaded figure-of-eight. When using a personal climbing harness, the Karabiner must be attached via the belay loop (where present), while the knot must be attached via a double-tie in point in the harness.
- No lying or sitting down while belaying.
- Mobile phones or cameras are not to be attached to you while climbing.
- Lead Climbing is restricted (see Lead Climbing Policy within the gym).
- While Lead Climbing, the rethreaded figure-of-eight with a stopper is the only knot to be used as an attachment. The bow line knot is not permitted.
- Safety equipment must all meet current UIAA standards for climbing equipment. Management reserves the right to refuse the use of personal safety equipment. Whelan, tree lopper, riggers or any homemade harness are not to be used in this centre.
- Auto-locking belay devices such as the Petzl Grigri, Trango Cinch, and Faders Sum are not permitted to be used in the centre. The Munter Hitch is also not permitted to be used in the centre.
- No bouldering without a spotter.
- Children under the age of 15 are not permitted to boulder unless under the guidance of a Hardrock Instructor.
- Groups are not permitted to boulder unless it has been specifically organised prior to activity.
- No un-roped climbing.
- No running in the centre.
- No loose chalk. Chalk must be in a chalk ball in a chalk bag.
- Climbing shoes must be worn while climbing.
- All hire equipment must be returned otherwise current replacement costs will apply.
- Parents and group leaders are responsible for the behaviour of their children and any children in their care.
- No food or drink is to be consumed in the climbing area.
- No chewing gum permitted.
- Hardrock does not take responsibility for personal belongings left in the centre.
- No bags or personal belongings are to be kept in the climbing area.
- Smoking is not permitted in the centre. All climbing gear must be taken off if smoking outside the centre. Please dispose of cigarette butts thoughtfully.
- Due to the Privacy Act - no photos or video recordings are to be taken unless you have permission from Hardrock Management.
- Refunds - please see Refunds Policy.

Failure to comply with Hardrock Centre Rules as stated above may result in Management asking you to leave the premises. Management reserves the right to refuse entry.
